



Lehigh Carbon Community College and Luzerne County Community College were recently awarded, as partners, a three year, \$1.7 million dollar U.S. Department of Labor grant to Strengthen workforce skills in the Logistics and Transportation and Advanced Manufacturing industries in our region. The grant and its programs are called “Careers on the Move”.

Pipeline talent, skills upgrade, and career exploration for youth are the focus areas for Careers on the Move.

What’s it mean to employers?

- extremely low cost training for forklift operators, warehouse workers, CDL Class A drivers, Diesel Mechanics and Industrial Maintenance technicians or mechanics
- classes for employees to study business, logistics, manufacturing technology and other degrees at either community college
